





GUIDELINES

International Steering Committee Asia-Pacific Microwave Conference

1. OBJBCT

The aim of the Asia-Pacific Microwave conference, subsequently referred to as the APMC, shall be the furthering of contact between engineers and scientists in aspects of fields of microwave and shorter wave research and development. This shall particularly encourage contact and interchange of ideas for workers from within the Asia-Pacific region, but will also include contributions from and contact with workers from all other regions of the world.

2. HOST NATIONS

The APMC shall be considered to cover those nations conventionally accepted as lying within the general region bounded by Korea in the North-east, New Zealand in the South-east, east of the Russian Urals in the North-west and Iran in the South-west.

3. INTERTIONAL STEERING COMMITTEE

This organization shall be known as the International Steering Committee of the Asia Pacific Microwave Conference, hereafter known as the ISC. Its objects shall be structuring of the formal program series of the APMC, and provision of information between conferences to facilitate the smooth transfer of conference from nation to nation. To carry out its object it shall ensure continuity between successive Conferences and maintain the ISC with other similar conferences in related fields around the world.

4. MEMBERSHIP OF ISC

The membership of the ISC shall come from the committees of the current, past and designated future organizing committees of the APMC. It may also include some nominated persons that can contribute expertise in relevant fields to the organization of the APMCs. These persons may include representatives from other microwave conferences, technical specialists, conference managers, and any others with particular skills that will facilitate the APMCs.

5. OFFICERS OF ISC

Chairperson of the ISC is appointed by the committee of the current APMC.

6. RECORD OF ISC MEETINGS

The chairperson of the ISC is responsible for making and keeping the records of the ISC meetings, and distributing them to the host nations, 7, REGISTRATION OF CONFERENCECE LOGO

It is recommended that the logo used by the APMC be registered in each of host nations to make it freely available for general use.

THE NAMING OF APMC PRIZE

This prize is called as APMC xx Prize where xx is the year of an APMC. (Approved by the ISC of APMC 1998 held in Yokohama on December 9, 1998.)

THE NAMING OF FUTURE APMCs.

Future APMCs are named after the city of the venue, instead of the country. For instance, APMC 2000 is named as APMC 2000 (Sydney). (Approved by the ISC of APMC 1999 held in Singapore on December 1, 1999.)

THE MEMBERS OF INTERNATIONAL STEERING COMMITTEE

Each entity should have 2 members on the International Steering Committee. The intention is to provide continuity of reporting, an alternate contact point and a way of developing the next generation of APMC organizers.

ISC SUMMER MEETINGS

- 1. Motivation
 - i) To enhance the presence of "Microwave (MW) research" in Asia Pacific region.
 - ii) To concrete the position of APMC as one of "the world's major MW conferences" with IMS and EuMC.
 - iii) To concentrate to publish high qualified technical contents for above objectives.

- 2. The history of the established ISC summer meeting
 - i) In the ISC meeting at APMC2006, we resolved that ISC meetings will be held twice a year.
 - ii) Based on this agreed regulation, the APMC2007 committee (Thailand) and the APMC2008 committee (Hong Kong) arranged additional ISC meetings in summer time frame. For the summer ISC meetings, the host committees of APMC2007 and APMC2008 supported accommodation for the meeting attendees.
 - iii) The best efforts of APMC2007/2008 committees made following superior results:
- Improvements of ISC functionalities,
- High qualified technical contents with international reviewers,
- Increase of paper submission number.
- 3. Guideline
 - The host committee for the future APMC will continue the above scheme established in APMC2007/2008:
 - two ISC meetings (summer and winter) in a year,
 - accommodation support for two official ISC members[*] for each entity in the summer ISC meeting upon request.
